How to Find the Experience

Once logged in on the VXRLabs homepage, navigate to the "Subjects" tab, select the "Forensics" option from the left-side menu, then select the "Crime Scene Investigation" option.

Gameplay Instructions

For this experience, you will load into a neighborhood environment with your CSI van parked on the street in front of the houses where various crimes have occurred.

- 1. Put on your PPE.
- 2. Choose a house to investigate.
- 3. Gather evidence, take crime scene photos, and conduct presumptive tests on any fluids or powders found on scene.
- 4. Store all samples and bagged contents in the evidence box on scene.
- 4. Deposit evidence box into the back of your Crime Scene Van. If all evidence has been gathered, the box will glow green. If you are missing a significant clue, it will glow red and you will need to return to the scene to find what you missed.
- 3. Find the central location of the scene such as where the body is and work outwards collecting evidence using the tools at your disposal as you go (see the CSI Tutorial to learn what is possible).
- 4. Return all evidence to the Evidence Loading Zone in the van and use your Inventory and other mechanics to keep track of what you have learned.
